This show is sponsored by the Piedmont Dairy Goat Association.

Entry fees are \$8.00 per animal per ring; or \$28.00 for all for rings. **To avoid late fees, entries must be sent to Glenda Noble. You can mail them to Glenda Noble, 14752 Cool Springs Road, Cl**

PENS: All pens will be assigned by show officials and there will be no pen fee. There are various pens available. If you are only showing on Sunday for just the one day you can show from your trailer at the show grounds.

***This show is sanctioned by ADGA and its rules shall govern. Only ADGA, AGS, and CGS registered animals are eligible for this show.

***The base date for computing ages is the date of the respective show. There is no pre-show milking.

***All animals entering the show grounds must be healthy. For out-of-state animals, health certificates are required.

***All animals must be checked in with the veterinarian and the show secretary by 7:30AM on Saturday.

***Since there may be spectators, please *(as you would during the State Fair)* keep all valuables at home.

***Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times while in the barns, tents, and show rings by everyone.

***The Show Committee is not responsible for losses, injury or accidents incurred before, during or after the show.

***There is a 0 tolerance for any underage drinking and any violators will be asked to leave. Entry is free.

Show Officials have the responsibility for enforcing rules, maintaining standards, and solving problems.

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

The Show Committee strongly recommends that exhibitors wear “whites” when showing their goats. This show is for exhibitors only.

CHECK-IN: The show secretary will be available on Friday from 12:00 noon till 5:00PM and from 6:45AM – 7:30AM on Saturday.

ENTRIES: Please understand that once you enter animals, those animals are counted in the numbers to make the breedings.

BEDDING: First bedding is **NOT PROVIDED**. Bagged shavings will be available for purchase. You must resupply your own bedding.
